City Council Meeting
Tuesday, December 1, 2020
City Council Chambers**

PRE-COUNCIL SESSION

City Clerk Frank Lesko called the Pre Council Session of the Springfield City Council to Order on Tuesday, December 1, 2020 in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Center West.

CITY COUNCIL SESSION

Mayor Jim Langfelder called the December 1, 2020 meeting of the Springfield City Council to order at 5:32 PM. He invited everyone to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Lesko took the roll call of members.

Clerk Lesko announced there was a quorum for a meeting.

Mayor Langfelder thanked Bernie Schoenburg for his years of reporting. A proclamation was issued to the State Journal Register and another proclamation was given to Chief Reyne for his years of service.

Next, Mayor Langfelder asked for a motion to dispense with a reading of the minutes of the November 17, 2020 City Council meeting and approve the minutes. Alderman McMenamin made the motion to approve and Alderman Redpath seconded. The motion passed on a voice vote of 10-0.

Next, Mayor Langfelder asked for a motion to incorporate Pre-Council first reading of ordinances into the record of the Council meeting. Alderman Redpath made the motion with Alderman Hanauer seconding the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 10-0 voting yes.

Alderman Redpath made a motion to amend agenda item 2020-480 with Alderman McMenamin seconding the motion. Motion passed with a roll call vote of 10-0 voting yes. Motion did not passed with a roll call vote of 5 yes and 4 no votes (Redpath, Fulgenzi, McMenamin and Hanauer). Alderwoman Conley was not present for this vote. Motion to move this item to debate was made by Alderman Redpath and seconded by Alderman McMenamin. Motion passed on a roll call vote of 10-0 voting yes. Alderwoman Turner asked to co-sponsor this agenda item.

Next, Mayor Langfelder asked for a motion to approve the Consent Agenda on to final passage. Alderman Hanauer made the motion and Alderman Proctor seconded the motion. A roll-call vote was taken to pass the Consent Agenda with 10-0 voting yes.

Mayor Langfelder asked to suspend the regular rules to add Agenda Items:

Alderman Redpath asked for someone to attend our next meeting from Public Health.

Alderman Gregory asked about the warming center and heating issues.

Alderwoman Turner mentioned National Aids Day as December 1, 2020.

Mayor Langfelder entertained a motion for adjournment. The motion was made by Alderman Donelan and seconded by Alderman Hanauer. The December 1, 2020 Council Meeting adjourned at 6:41 PM.
