PRE-COUNCIL SESSION

City Clerk Frank Lesko called the Pre Council Session of the Springfield City Council to Order on Tuesday, June 16, 2020 in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Center West.

ZONING & CITY COUNCIL SESSION

Mayor Jim Langfelder called the June 16, 2020 meeting of the Springfield City Council to order at 5:30 PM. He invited everyone to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Lesko took the roll call of members.

Clerk Lesko announced there was a quorum for a meeting.

Next, Mayor Langfelder read the zoning docket.

Treasurer Buscher read in her report. Alderman Redpath motioned to pass the treasurer's report with Alderman Hanauer second the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote of 10-0 voting yes.

Much discussion between Council was had on the items in Committee. Motion filed with 3 voting yes (Redpath, Fulgenzi, McMenamin) and 7 voting no. Items all remain in Committee.
