**PRE-COUNCIL SESSION**

City Clerk Frank Lesko called the Pre Council Session of the Springfield City Council to Order on Tuesday, August 5, 2020 in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Center West.

**ZONING & CITY COUNCIL SESSION**

Mayor Jim Langfelder called the August 5, 2020 meeting of the Springfield City Council to order at 5:30 PM. He invited everyone to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Lesko took the roll call of members.

Clerk Lesko announced there was a quorum for a meeting.

Next, Mayor Langfelder asked for a motion to dispense with a reading of the minutes of the July 21, 2020 City Council meeting and approve the minutes. Alderman Donelan made the motion to approve and Alderwoman DiCenso seconded. The motion passed on a voice vote of 10-0.
