

Minutes of Springfield City Council Meeting Tuesday, March 1, 2022 City Council Chambers

PRE-COUNCIL SESSION

Clerk Lesko called the Pre-Council Session of the Springfield City Council to Order on Tuesday, March 1, 2022 in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Center West.

CITY COUNCIL SESSION

Mayor Jim Langfelder called the March 1, 2022 meeting of the Springfield City Council to order at 5:32 PM. He invited everyone to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Lesko took the roll call of members.

Clerk Lesko announced there was a quorum for a meeting.

Mayor Langfelder read some excerpts from his father Ozzie Langfelder's book. Asked for a moment of silence for Ukraine.

Judge Roger Holmes gave Inspector General's Report to City Council. Discussion had between Alderpersons and Judge Roger Holmes.

Springfield Police Chief Kenneth Scarlett presented Springfield Police Department 2021 Annual Review. Discussion had between Springfield Police Chief Kenneth Scarlette and Alderpersons.

Mayor Langfelder asked for a motion to dispense with a reading of the minutes of the February 15, 2022 City Council meeting and approve the minutes. Alderman Donelan made the motion to approve the minutes and Alderwoman Purchase seconded. The motion passed with a voice vote of 10-0 voting yes.
