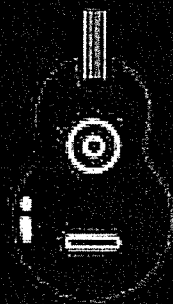

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted ordinance 220-05-22 for the purchase of six fire engines and one quint truck for the Springfield Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Springfield Fire Department desires the purchase of fire equipment for the fire apparatuses; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Code of the City of Springfield requires that this contract be let by sealed competitive bidding to the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above, the City Purchasing Agent has determined that Banner Fire Equipment, Municipal Emergency Services ("MES"), AEC Fire Safety & Security, and Dinges Fire Company have submitted the lowest responsible bid for these purchases as outlined on Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Banner Fire Equipment is willing to provide the equipment as listed on "Exhibit A" in an amount not to exceed \$205,150.11; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Emergency Services is willing to provide the equipment as listed on "Exhibit A" in an amount not to exceed \$391,181.70; and

WHEREAS, AEC Fire Safety & Security is willing to provide the equipment as listed on "Exhibit A" in an amount not to exceed \$297,912.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the code to allow for Adult-Use Cannabis; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:**

Section 1: That the City Council hereby amends 155.496 of the 1988 City of Springfield Code of Ordinances, as amended, pertaining to Cannabis Organizations modifying separation provisions of the 1988 Springfield City Code of Ordinances, as amended, as follows:

CHAPTER 155. – ZONING

CHAPTER 155. - ZONING

§ 155.496. Special requirements for cultivation centers and adult-use cannabis business establishments except adult-use dispensary.

- (a) *Location.* No cultivation center or adult-use cannabis business establishments except adult-use dispensary, adult-use craft grower, and adult-use cannabis transporting organization shall be located within 2,500 feet of the property line of a pre-existing public or private pre-school or elementary or secondary school or day care center, day care home, group day care home, part day care facility, or an area zoned for residential use. Such distances shall be measured linearly and shall be the shortest distance between the closest points of the property lines of the places. No adult-use craft grower, or adult-use infuser, or adult-use cannabis transporting organization shall be located within 1,500 feet of the property line of a pre-existing public or private pre-school or elementary or secondary school or day care center, day care home, group day care home, part day care facility, or an area zoned for residential use, except adult-use craft grower or adult-use infuser organizations shall be allowed on pre-existing parcels zoned I-1 & I-2 located no less than 200 feet from existing parcels zoned for residential use and no less than 500 feet from pre-existing public or private pre-school or elementary or secondary school or day care center, day care home, group day care home, or part day care facility. Such distances shall be measured linearly and shall be the shortest distance between the closest points of the property lines of the places. This requirement shall not be subject to variance in any zoning district. If a boundary line measured touches upon any portion of a parcel or lot, the parcel or lot shall be within the area being identified by the city zoning administrator.
