WHEREAS, the City of Springfield has been negotiating over the past several months with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 193 (Engineers), with regard to a collective bargaining agreement for Electrical Workers of the Office of Public Utilities; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to terms of a tentative collective bargaining agreement effective June 1, 2022, through May 31, 2027, a copy of which shall be on file in the Office of the City Clerk and as summarized on attached Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby approves the tentative collective bargaining agreement between the City of Springfield, Office of Public Utilities, and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 193 (Engineers), effective from June 1, 2022, through May 31, 2027, a copy of which shall be on file in the Office of the City Clerk and as summarized on Attached Exhibit A. The Mayor is authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Springfield.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and recording by the City Clerk.

A minimum annual wage scale was established for Engineers I – V, Engineer Techs I - VI, and Engineer Tech Specialists I - V.

Section 11.2(c). Professional Certifications:

Article XI – Development and Promotion. Sect 11.2 (c) Any member of the unit that earns any of the following certificates or licenses, **as required by the Employer**, shall immediately receive a one-time \$ 500.00 salary increase. **Employees that currently hold these certificates will receive a one-time \$ 500.00 upon ratification of the agreement.**

This increase is in addition to any other applicable salary increases such as across-the-board or merit-based increases. This certification must be maintained in order for the employee to retain the one-time \$ 500.00 salary increase and associated compounded increases. If the eligible employee's certification lapses, a corresponding salary reduction shall take place.

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the city council previously passed ordinance no. 342-08-21 authorizing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) subrecipient agreement no. 20-SR-0002, to assist the Salvation Army in operating a Safety Net Shelter to adult men and women who find themselves homeless in the Springfield area, in the amount of \$477,934.64; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) subrecipient agreement no. 20-SR-0002 was previously amended to extend the grant date from August 1, 2022 through January 31, 2022, with no additional monies required; and

WHEREAS, the Salvation Army is requesting a one year extension of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) subrecipient agreement no. 20-SR-0002, from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$402,934.64; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to authorize amendment no. 2 to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) subrecipient agreement no. 20-SR-0002 authorizing a one year extension, from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$402,934.64; and

WHEREAS, a copy of amendment no. 2 to the agreement shall be located in the office of the City Clerk.
