PRE-COUNCIL SESSION

City Clerk Frank Lesko called the Pre-Council Session of the Springfield City Council to order on Tuesday May 2, 2023.

CITY COUNCIL SESSION

Mayor Jim Langfelder called the May 2, 2023 meeting of the Springfield City Council to order at 5:30 PM. He invited everyone to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Lesko announced there was a quorum for a meeting.
