Alderman Hanauer has indicated he intends to make a Motion to Amend Something Previously Adopted, moving to Amend this Ordinance, as Amended, to remove all language adopted by Proposed Amendment #1, passed by City Council on April 15, 2025, and approve the ordinance as it appeared during its first reading.

Alderman Gregory has indicated that if a Motion to Amend Something Previously Adopted is made to alter or eliminate the changes made by Proposed Amendment #1, he intends to move to Amend said motion to make all SSGA funding contingent on a 25% minimum of Board and Executive Board members comprised of racial or ethnic minorities who reside in one of the twelve lowest income census tracts, insert conflict of interest provisions regarding SSGA members contracting with the City, insert compliance timelines, and require an annual certification.

Alderwoman Purchase has indicated that if a Motion to Amend Something Previously Adopted is made to alter or eliminate the changes made by Proposed Amendment #1, she intends to move to Amend said motion to allocate \$325,000 in total in funding, with \$75,000 going to the Minority Business and Community Advancement Working Council established by Proposed Amendment #1 and \$250,000 being allocated as set forth in the ordinance as originally presented for first read, with all remaining provisions of Proposed Amendment #1 remaining in place. Said amendment would further make a supplemental appropriation for the additional funds if such an appropriation is needed.

City Council Rules and Procedure

Rule 8.1. Addressing the Council. Any person desiring to address the Council shall first be recognized by the presiding officer. Except for zoning matters and emergency ordinances, all requests by members of the public to address the Council during the Council's consideration of "Ordinances and resolutions - final action," shall be made to the Clerk in writing with the subject matter stated, not less than one (1) working day before the next scheduled Council meeting. Persons addressing the Council shall limit their statements to five minutes unless further time is granted by the presiding officer. This Rule shall not apply to officers and employees of the City of Springfield, Illinois. Any other comments by the public pertaining to City business shall be made during the Council's Order of Business under Public forum addressing City business.
